# **REAL Families, REAL Lives, REAL Transformation**

- The average cost of a Family in the BuxMont Bridge of Hope Program is \$18,000.
- The average time a Family spends in the program is 24 months.
- The average size for a Bridge of Hope BuxMont family includes the single parent with three children.
- The average monthly cost to support one of our Bridge of Hope BuxMont Families is \$750 per month.
- Graduates have obtained Permanent Housing, Financial Self Sufficiency, and are providing a Stable Home Life for their Family.

Bridge of Hope BuxMont is proud to share with you a great opportunity for the 2010-2011 fiscal year. Our goal is to add two families to our program during this fiscal year. That will give us a total of four families working toward gaining permanent housing and more importantly self sufficiency and stabilization for their family.

I am sure you can easily imagine the difficulties that have faced non-profit organizations as a whole during the current economic conditions. I am also sure you understand that there is an even GREATER need for our organization simply due to the economy.

We are asking you to partner with us in our HELPING HOPE GROW campaign. The ways to help are simple. All organizations whether non-profit or for profit struggle with cash flow and the problems that ensue from meeting monthly budgets. One of the goals of our HELPING HOPE GROW campaign is to add 85 monthly donors at the \$25 level to our program.

But in 2008, Florence and her circle of mentoring friends from Christ United Methodist Church celebrated her graduation

from Bridge of Hope BuxMont after a diligent journey towards self-sufficiency. She left the program driving her own car, in a permanent job with benefits, and paying her own rent in a two-bedroom apartment.

Florence remains the head of a single income household and she will need to live on a tight budget; but with the encouragement of her new circle of friends, she learned who she can be in the midst of adversity. And her mentors gained an appreciation of what they could give in spite of seemingly insurmountable challenges.
